Matters Arising

Car park signs – Brian has this in hand.

Kitchen wall – Ian has this in hand.

Heating – the boiler has been switched off occasionally when the weather has been warmer.

Crockery – this has arrived and is very suitable. Some members of the hall committee ended up providing the tea for the Revivalist Meeting on the 9<sup>th</sup> May. The tea was paid for and there is £72 to bank for this.

Carnival – This year Mrs Jane Rooke has kindly accepted to be the President at the carnival. The float insurance will cost £55, the renewal form and cheque will be sent. The band Stix have confirmed and will cost £300 on the night. The Parlour Racing is all set for this Friday and 12 races have been received. Committee members are selling the horses. We need to confirm with Adam and Kim that the field is still available for the Sports Day and Fiona will enquire with Event Insurances if there is any appropriate insurance available too. There is tea/coffee and sugar left over from the Revivalist tea but discussion of the refreshments and details of the Sports Day may require a further meeting prior to the usual monthly meeting if there is to be a barbecue and medals, etc.

Glass for the back room door – Ian has this in hand.

Fencing to the lower car park – it is still necessary to sort out the boundaries around the hall. Maria has made enquiries of the Land Registry as the deeds of the hall are poor to read. The Land Registry can send a more detailed map which Maria will request before we can go further with the fencing.

Hoover – we will wait until the stage flooring is sorted before investing in a new Hoover.

The stage and disabled access/fire-escapes - this is ongoing as we have no further information at present.
